## Program and inclusions

### 1 Arrival and Tirana

The day starts with a walk through the city center. Over the last 25 years, Tirana has transformed from a dark, communist-era city into a vibrant, international metropolis. Continue to your hotel in the Durres area.

- 1 x private coach transfer from Tirana airport to the city centre and to the hotel

### 2 Apollonia und Berat (240 km)

Drive to Apollonia, a key ancient Illyrian city on the Via Egnatia, to explore its ruins, including temples, the Agora, and a theater. Continue to Berat, the "City of 1000 Windows," with hillside white houses and historic sites like its castle, churches, and mosques. Enjoy a wine tasting with a snack in the Berat area before returning to your hotel in Durres.

### 3 Vlora, Himara and Saranda - hotel change (240 km)

Drive to Vlora, where Albania declared independence in 1912. Journey through mountain villages to the 1,027m Llogara Pass, then descend to the Riviera and visit Himara. Continue to Saranda, famous for its scenic promenade, for dinner and an overnight stay.

### 4 Butrint and Blue Eye (80 km)

Visit Butrint, a UNESCO site near Saranda, to explore its iconic ancient ruins. Stop at the Byzantine Mesopotam Church and the Blue Eye Spring before returning to Saranda for dinner at your hotel.

### 5 Gjirokastra, Korce and Pogradec - hotel change (300 km)

### 6 Elbasan - hotel change (130 km)

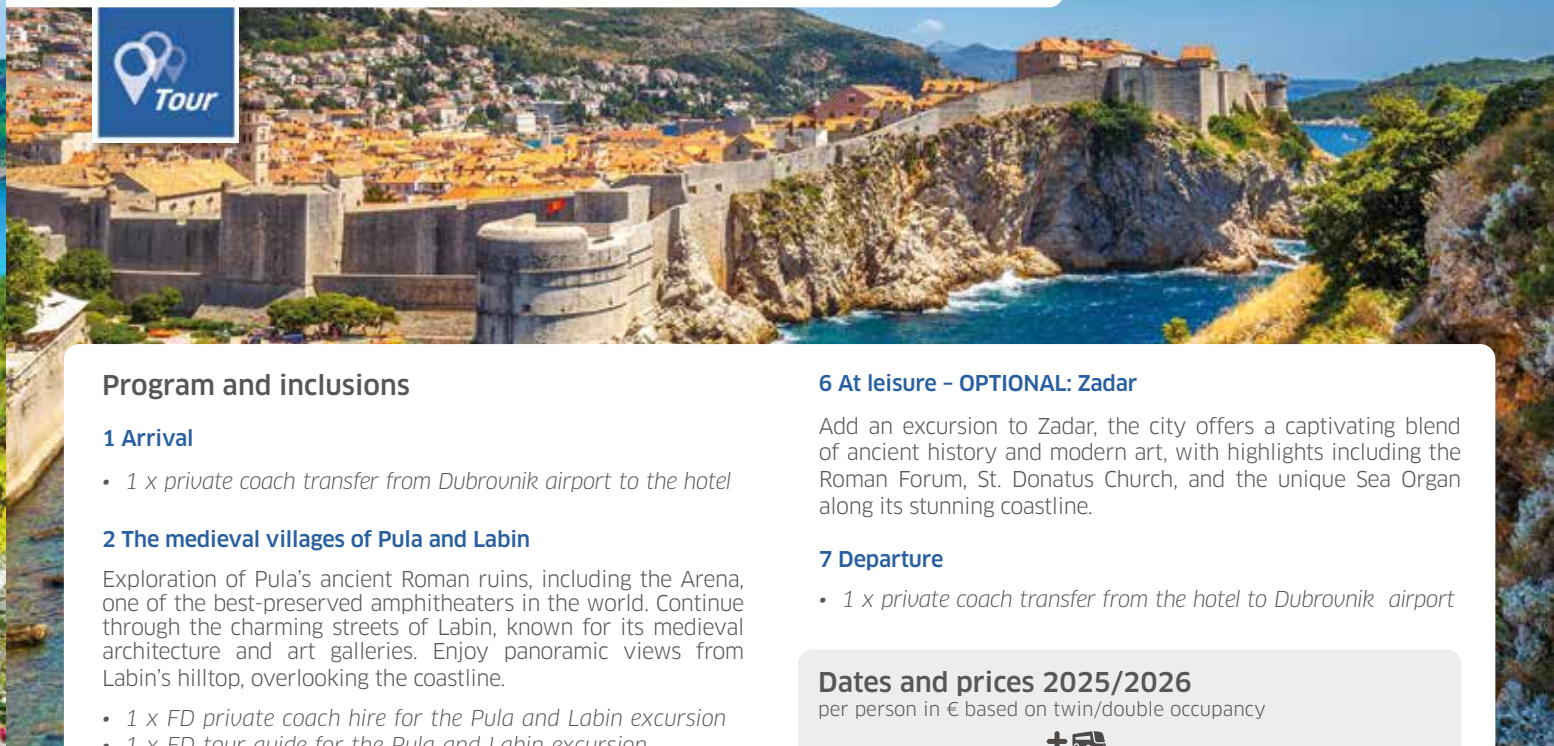
